Athens —Naxos—Paros—and more*

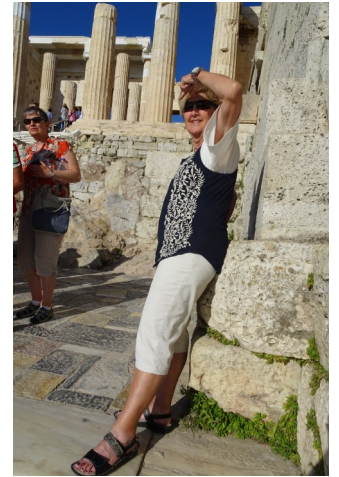
10 wonderful nights. Arrive September 12th and Depart September 22nd, 2025



By request, we've put together a fantastic trip to Greece! One can't go to Greece without visiting the Acropolis, the Plaka and the rest of what Athens has to offer. So, even though we've been on previous trips—we're going.

We will spend two nights in the historical center of **Athens**, then off by boat (4-5 hours) to the wonderful island of **Naxos**. A spot of white in the turquoise waters of the Aegean Sea, the

island of Naxos is a unique blend of ancient ruins and beach culture. The largest of the Cycladic Islands, Naxos is the childhood home of none other than Zeus, king of the gods. Upon arrival in Naxos, hike over a causeway to Palatia, where the Portara, a stone gateway to an ancient temple that no longer exists, stands alone, the symbol of the island. At sunset, the views of the island, and the sea beyond, are breathtaking. We will stay 4 glorious nights in Naxos, with a day trip to **Delos/Mykonos**



. Then moving to the nearby island of **Paros** for 3 overnights with its unrivalled natural beauty, beaches with crystal clear waters, exceptional Byzantine footpaths connecting traditional villages with breathtaking landscapes, and the artistic village of **Lefkes**. How about a day trip to the quaint town of

Antiparos, it's Cave and the islet of Despotiko? All of this is just a taste because there is so much to do on these islands... or you can choose to just relax on a pristine white beach and paint. Finally, we will return to Athens and overnight in **Glyfada** before departing for home.
